B. UPDATE ON MONEY FROM CANCUN.

C. UPDATE ON THE DFEH DISCRIMINATION/HARASSMENT FILING.

Our attorney has sent a 10 page letter to the Department of Fair Employment and Housing. This letter explains that Gamblers Anonymous International Service Office has never had 5 employees, plus other pertinent information relating to this issue, therefore this complaint is frivolous and should not go any further.

3. NEW BUSINESS

A. REVIEW STATUS OF BANK ACCOUNTS AND OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION RELATED TO THE I.S.O.

All data on bank accounts were looked over. As of July1, 2018 we have \$27,992.14 more than we did on July 1, 2017. The Hotline Debit card will be closed out before the August meeting. Also the June 30 Year End Inventory was reviewed.

Gamblers Anonymous should remain forever non-professional, but our service centers may employ special workers.

When the History on page 1 of the Combo Book was written, I wonder if when "they" said "groups are flourishing throughout the world", "they" really had any idea the size our Fellowship would be today.

Gamblers Anonymous still believes that the members are the most qualified to conduct the affairs of the Fellowship. At one time the Gamblers Anonymous **National** Service Office was operated by one member, part time, out of a house. Today, Gamblers Anonymous **International** Service Office has three employees (one member and two "special workers") all of whom work full time (if not more), and operates out of a suite of offices in an industrial park with over a 2,000 sf warehouse to house our literature.

The amount of Starter Kits for new meetings, purchased literature and requests for help throughout the world has really accelerated in the last few years. As our Red Book states, "The validity of professional assistance is not in question. Gamblers Anonymous members are urged to seek outside help, if required. However, if professional therapists were to operate within the Fellowship, their views might conflict with Gamblers Anonymous principles. By remaining non-professional, Gamblers Anonymous avoids the controversies that would inevitably arise". With the onset of gambling throughout the country and the hundreds of offers that come into the International Service Office for help from counselors and gaming professionals it is comforting to know that we CAN & WILL remain "forever non-professional".
